HoCoPoLitSo features best-selling author **Hugo Hamilton**, who will read from his work *The Speckled People: A Memoir of a Half-Irish Childhood*. Told in the language of a child, the life-story recounts the complexities of living in a dual language household of Irish and German, where the English language was held hostage by his staunch, nationalist father. Translated into fifteen languages, the story resonates as it touches on the absorbing inheritance of cultural divides. "You inherit your identity, your history, like a birthmark that you can't wash off," writes Hamilton.

Awarded the Rooney Prize for Irish Literature, France's Prix Femina Etranger, and Italy's Giuseppe Berto Prize, Hamilton has written six novels, two memoirs, and a short story collection. He is noted for his works *Sad Bastard*, *Headbanger*, and *The Sailor in the Wardrobe*. *The Speckled People* made its world premiere at the Gate Theatre in Dublin. His works remind us that there is more than one Irish story, "I'm not afraid of being homesick and having no language to live in. I don't have to be like anyone else. I'm walking on the wall and nobody can stop me."
